

# Missouri River Kayaking Day – October 1<sup>st</sup>

## What to bring:

- Hat, sunscreen, sunglasses
- Plenty of water
- Lunch/snacks
- Weather and kayak appropriate clothing
  - Layers are a good way to prepare for changing weather
  - Strap on sandals or water shoes (no flip-flops)
- **Note:** Anything you bring with you must either be left in your vehicle, or carried in your kayak with you. While kayaks do have some dry storage areas, these areas are small and are not entirely water proof. My recommendation is to not bring anything with you that cannot get wet. Anything that will not fit in the dry boxes must be put in between your legs or behind your seat in the kayak.

Below is a schedule outline with estimated times:

- 9:00 A.M. – Arrive at Sanger boat ramp and shuttle to Washburn
  - 9:45 A.M. – Group arrives at Riverside Park
  - 10:00 A.M. – Unload and get ready
  - 10:30 A.M. – Quick safety and first time kayak overview
  - 11:00 P.M. – Depart for Sanger boat ramp on Missouri River
  - 2:30 P.M. – Arrive at Sanger boat ramp
- Please arrive at Sanger boat ramp by 9:00 A.M. We will be using a large van to shuttle everyone up to Washburn, and we cannot force everyone to wait for you if you are late.
  - You can pay the \$5 fee (per person) and sign waivers upon arrival. Cash or check is accepted.
  - IF you rent through us it will be a \$20 fee. Includes kayak, accessories, and transportation.
  - This event is weather dependent, and you will be notified of cancellation ASAP.

Directions to Sanger boat ramp in Cross Ranch State Park:

- Head west on I-94 through Mandan
- Exit North onto State Highway 25 (Exit has Flying J Gas station on south side of I-94)
- Drive approximately 18 miles north on Highway 25
- Make a right turn onto 28<sup>th</sup> Ave. SW
- After driving 5 miles north, make a right turn onto 16<sup>th</sup> St. SW
- After driving 4 miles east, make a right turn onto River Road
- The entrance to the boat landing is an immediate left turn off of River Road
