Online Campsite Reservations Available at Sully Creek State Park

The North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department has added its non-horse campsites at Sully Creek State Park to the online reservation system. Park visitors will now be able to reserve non-horse campsites online at www.parkrec.nd.gov or through the reservation Call Center at 1-800-807-4723, for the months of April through November.

Whitetail Flats and Cedar campground loops offer a total of 22 primitive campsites for non-horse camping and Little Muddy Breaks campground loop offers 17 primitive horse campsites & corrals for reservation by calling the park staff directly at 701-623-2024. Located in the heart of the North Dakota badlands, Sully Creek is just minutes away from the historic town of Medora and Theodore Roosevelt National Park. This primitive park offers mountain bikers, hikers, and horseback riders trailhead access to the Maah Daah Hey Trail.

Both horse and non-horse campsite reservations for Little Missouri State Park must still be made by contacting the park directly at 701-764-5256.
