To better accommodate park visitors, the Pioneer Heritage Center at Icelandic State Park will now be open on Saturdays from 1-5 pm and closed on Sundays. Weekday hours remain Monday through Friday from 9 am – 5 pm. Stop in during the month of December to view the holiday decorations.
