NDPRD awards Community Grant projects

The North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department recently awarded nine community grant projects through North Dakota's Outdoor Community Grant Program. The Community Grant Program offers Outdoor Recreation Facilities and Recreation Leadership grants. The 63rd Legislative Assembly appropriated \$500,000 to the program to be distributed during the 2013-2015 biennium.

A total of 25 applications were received, totaling over \$1.5 million in funding requests. Outdoor Recreation Facilities grants were awarded to:

- Barnes County Park Board—Little Yellowstone and Clausen Springs Campsite Enhancements
- Bismarck Parks and Recreation District—Hillside Pool Redevelopment
- Cavalier Public School District #6—Cavalier Public School Playground
- City of Langdon—Langdon City Park Bathroom Remodel and New Playground Equipment
- City of Medora—Medora Swimming Pool Renovation
- Morton County Parks—Graner Park Expansion Phase II
- Nelson County Park Board—Stump Lake Park Improvements
- Pleasant Township—Hickson Community Center Playground and Basketball Court
