Slumping causes Pembina Gorge trail closure

Recent heavy rains have caused slumping on the Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) trail in the Pembina Gorge State Recreation Area. The slumping has restricted access to the trail which will be closed until further notice.

The 12 mile looped trail is designed for OHV use, but is also open to hikers, mountain bikers and horseback riders. The OHV trail is made possible through the North Dakota Park and Recreation Department's partnerships with state agency and private landowners. An additional 12-mile loop is being planned as well as more traditional, non-motorized trail opportunities.
