ADDITIONAL INFO

- Register online via ShowClix for the desired day camp(s); participants must be described age at the time of camp.
- Campers should be dropped off at the LMSP office no earlier than 15 minutes prior to start of camp.
- Pick up is at the beach for most camps; OHV camps do not conclude with beach time.
- Participants should wear good footwear and bring sunscreen, bug spray, water bottle and swimwear/towel, if applicable.
- Registration includes snack and lunch.
- Participants for June 19 & Aug 7 camps should bring own bikes and helmets, if possible. LMSP does have small supply of bikes/helmets for those in need.
- July 17 & 31 high ropes camps will require a \$35 ShowClix registration and additional \$30 payment to Camp Metigoshe due day of camp along with separate liability waiver with parent/guardian required.
- Ticket sales are final, no exceptions. Refunds will not be available unless LMSP cancels the camp(s). Registered participants no longer able to attend can send a replacement assuming notification is given at least one week prior to scheduled camp.
- All vehicles entering any ND State Park are subject to ND state park entrance fees.
